RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
ESTABLISHING FEES FOR FILMING ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles has adopted Ordinance No. 597N.S. which establishes regulations for "Filming Activities"; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 597N.S. does prescribe an application form for individuals and companies desiring to film with the City of El Paso de Robles; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 597N.S. does authorize the establishment of a fee schedule for the processing of film permits and to cover the costs of City personnel required to be present during filming activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Photography/Film Permit form identified as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated as part of this document, is hereby authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following schedule of fees for filming activities is hereby established:

Application Fee	No Charge
Facility Use Fee*	Minimum of \$250.00 per day
City Personnel Time	Reimbursement at actual costs

* Based on current market rents and sites to be utilized.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FILMING

(Auth: Municipal Code Section 9.45.085)

1. Any person or entity wishing to use any City property or City roads for the purpose of motion picture production, television production or still photography shall apply for a permit to the Film Development Office on an application form established for this purpose.
2. The completed application form must contain all information specified therein, including insurance certificates showing compliance with Municipal Code Sec. 9.45.110, payment of application and/or use fees, and accompanied by payment of the security deposit set for the particular permit by the Film Development Director. If anything required is omitted, the Film Development Director will notify the applicant forthwith and the application will not be deemed filed until it has been completed.
3. Film Development Director will endeavor to issue permits within two (2) working days of submittal of a complete application. Permits requiring road closures will require 4-10 days additional time before a permit can be issued.
4. The permit must be signed by applicant (two copies) prior to issuance.
5. The permit is issued when a completed written permit document is signed by the Film Development Director and is delivered to the permittee.
6. The complete permit includes all attachments or addenda thereto and conditions of approval stated therein.
7. The permit may be amended by the Film Development Director whenever conditions in the field require it to protect public health, safety or property. Such amendment may state additional requirements for permittee and does require signature of permittee.
8. No alterations or variation of the terms of the permit shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by the parties thereto.
9. The Permittee agrees to comply with all terms and conditions contained in the film permit.
10. The Permittee shall comply with all the rules and regulations of the facility or institution subject to the film permit.
11. The permit must be kept on site at all times.
