

RESOLUTION NO. 90-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO
ESTABLISHING A PROHIBITED PARKING ZONE ON 13TH STREET
WITHIN THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES .

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee recommends that three parking spaces be eliminated to improve the right-turn lane traffic flow on 13th Street east of Spring Street; and

WHEREAS, the traffic congestion between the alley serving First Interstate Bank parking lot and Spring Street needs to be improved by completion of "red curbing" this half-block to allow better access out of the alley and a longer right-turn lane onto Spring Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to remove the existing parking spaces on 13th Street east between the alley serving First Interstate Bank and Spring Street to allow for no-parking.
