A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION OF \$10,000 FROM THE SIGNALIZATION  
DEVELOPMENT FUND FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CONTROLLER AND CABINET  
FOR THE 10TH & SPRING STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL

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WHEREAS, it has been determined that the controller for the traffic signal at 10th and Spring Street cannot be repaired; and

WHEREAS, staff concurs with Lee Wilson Electric that the cabinet and controller should be replaced with the standard 170 Model, similar to those used in the City's other signals; and


WHEREAS, Lee Wilson Electric estimates the removal and replacement cost not to exceed \$10,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the City Council authorize appropriation of \$10,000 from the Signalization Development Fund to the Street Maintenance account 100.320.5454 for replacement of the traffic signal controller and cabinet at the 10th & Spring Street intersection.

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: TRAFFIC SIGNAL -- 10TH AND SPRING, REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION, EMERGENCY REPAIRS

As an update to the signal breakdown, Lee Wilson Electric has searched for replacement parts throughout California. The City of San Bernardino is one of the only cities to have some parts for a controller like the one at this intersection.

They obtained some parts to try and fix the controller and found that it could not be repaired. They are now recommending a complete removal of the old controller and cabinet and replacement with the standard 170 model, similar to the City's other locations.

After review of the situation I concur with their recommendation and request your authorization to proceed with the emergency repair of the intersection with an amount not to exceed \$10,000. The money can be funded from unappropriated traffic signalization funds.

I will await your written authorization to proceed and appropriate budget number to use prior to having Lee Wilson proceed with the work.
