

RESOLUTION NO. 91-130

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
DESIGNATING SEPTEMBER 23-27, 1991 AS RIDESHARE WEEK

WHEREAS, the use of ridesharing as a means of transportation in California has the potential to reduce fuel consumption, air pollution, traffic congestion, transportation costs and parking needs; and

WHEREAS, the public and private business community within San Luis Obispo County has recognized the importance of ridesharing as an effective, low-cost solution to many transportation and environmental issues; and

WHEREAS, cities, counties, and states throughout the nation have recognized ridesharing as an effective component in a comprehensive transportation system that meets the needs of all citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is important for men and women who constitute the workforce of the County and the City of Paso Robles to be aware of the many benefits ridesharing has to offer to individuals and businesses; and

WHEREAS, during the week of September 23-27, 1991, the California Department of Transportation, San Luis Obispo Regional Ridesharing and other transportation-related groups throughout the state will be observing California Rideshare Week;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles designates the week of September 23-27, 1991 as Rideshare Week.
