

RESOLUTION NO. 91-160

**A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR VACATING A PORTION OF
James STREET (SURPLUS RIGHT-OF-WAY) AND GIVING NOTICE OF
TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON**

THE CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES does hereby resolve as follows:

1. That it is the intention of the City council to close and vacate a public right-of-way in James Street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of James Street lying between Cherry Street and the southerly right-of-way line of James Court as shown on Parcel Map PR 89-193.

2. For further particulars as to the proposed vacation, reference, is hereby made to a map and plan now on file in the Office of the City clerk of the City of Paso Robles.

3. That in the event of said closing, as hereby and above described, the City of Paso Robles may reserve a permanent public utility easement over the entire vacated street.


4. That JANUARY 7, 1992, 1991, at the hour of 7:30 P.M., on said date in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 1030 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California, is the time and place set forth for hearing all persons interested in or having objection to the proposed closing.

5. That the City Clerk of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published fifteen (15) days prior to the date set herein for hearing in the Paso Robles Country News, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Paso Robles, California.

6. The City Engineer of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place set for hearing hereon by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the public utility easement to be closed.
