A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 94-100 AND ADOPTING A REVISED RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1995-96
