

RESOLUTION NO. 96-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES APPROVING REVISED  
LANDFILL TIPPING FEES, REVISED SOLID WASTE  
COLLECTION RATES AND A PROMISSORY NOTE  
BETWEEN THE SOLID WASTE OPERATIONS FUND AND  
THE WATER OPERATIONS FUND

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 94-74, the City Council did lower landfill tipping fee rates in order to attract, in an open, competitive market environment, increased solid waste deliveries ; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently prevented from accepting larger quantities of solid waste materials while its application for a revised permit is pending; and

WHEREAS, the City did purchase real property adjacent to the current landfill site to meet future solid waste disposal requirements should the need arise; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently installing a new landfill cell which, even by itself, is of considerable cost to the City but is further aggravated by state mandates relative to the type and nature of construction; and

WHEREAS, contrary to adopted City fiscal policy, the Solid Waste Operations Fund is anticipated to end fiscal year 1996 with an operating loss; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of addressing all of the above noted in operating a municipal landfill in a fiscally responsible manner.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that:

1. Landfill tipping fee rates as identified in the attached Exhibit "A" are hereby adopted effective July 1, 1996; and
2. Solid Waste Collection rates as identified in the attached Exhibit "B" are hereby adopted effective July 1, 1996; and
3. The promissory note attached herewith as Exhibit "C" is hereby adopted and the Mayor is authorized to execute said note with an effective date of June 30, 1996.

\*\*City Only: This amount to be passed through to the City without regard to shared split.

Should a solid waste hauler other than Paso Robles Waste Disposal deliver commercial compacted refuse to the Paso Robles Landfill for thirty (30) consecutive days and the average daily tonnage is equal to or greater than 130 tons per day, the commercial compacted rate shall be decreased without further City Council action to \$25.00 per ton. The decrease shall be retroactively applied to the new hauler beginning with the first delivery day; shall be applied to all other current commercial compacted haulers other than Paso Robles Waste Disposal beginning with the first day of next calendar month and shall be applied to Paso Robles Waste Disposal beginning with the first day of the next billing month. Should the average daily tonnage drop below 130 tons per day, the rates shall be returned to the rates first established herein Exhibit "A".

Should landfill tipping fee rates be decreased in accordance with the special provision contained in Exhibit "A", solid waste collection rates shall be reduced in accordance with the same formula by which the rates were originally increased. Should landfill tipping fee rates be subsequently increased due to a decrease in solid waste deliveries, solid waste collection rates shall be increased accordingly.

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EXHIBIT "C"

PROMISSORY NOTE WITH INTEREST

\$843,500

June 30, 1996

For value received, the Solid Waste Operations Fund promises to pay to the Water Operations Fund at Paso Robles, California, the sum of Eight Hundred and Forty-three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$843,500) with interest at the rate of Seven and One-half Percent (7.5%) per annum from the date of this note until paid. The principal and all accrued interest shall be re-paid in equal monthly installments. Payments are due in advance on the first day of each month beginning July 1, 1996 and shall continue for 20 years or until such time as the remaining principal balance is paid in full.
