

RESOLUTION NO. 96-61

A resolution of the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles authorizing the Police Department to participate in a multiagency traffic safety/enforcement grant.

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol has received grand funds for the creation of a multiagency SR 41 and 46 Traffic Safety Corridor Project Task Force; and

WHEREAS, State Routes 41 and 46 from U.S. 101 to their intersections with Interstate 5 have been identified as the corridor for which a *Safety Action Plan* is to be developed; and

WHEREAS, the grant allows funds for law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force has agreed that increasing law enforcement is an important element in improving traffic safety on the corridor;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the Paso Robles Police Department to participate in the grant and authorizes the Chief of Police, to sign the participation agreement.
