

RESOLUTION NO. 96-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
GIVING PERMISSION TO REMOVE OAK TREES  
IN ACCORDANCE TO THE CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL  
OF TENTATIVE TRACT 1754

WHEREAS, on October 3, 1989, the City council granted Tentative Tract map approval for Tract 1754 by adopting Resolution 89-134; and

WHEREAS, the approved tentative tract map identified five (5) oak trees to be removed to accommodate the development plan for the tract; and

WHEREAS, during the final design for the tract, it was determined that two more oak trees will need to be removed in order to install a sewerline to serve the tract; and

WHEREAS, since the tentative map was approved, another oak tree has deteriorated and need to be removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council gives permission for the removal of eight (8) trees.

Section 2. That the applicant is required to install (2) 24-inch box trees (1-1/2 inch minimum caliper) for each tree removed for a total of 16 trees .
