

RESOLUTION No. 96-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
GIVING PERMISSION TO REMOVE AN OAK TREE
FOR PHASE II CONSTRUCTION OF WOODLAND PLAZA II

WHEREAS, on January 19, 1993, the City Council approved Planned Development 91-010 which permitted the construction of a regional commercial center in three phases; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 1995, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. 95-038 which approved the final details of Phase II construction of Woodland Plaza II; and

WHEREAS, this approval required the removal of an existing oak tree.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council gives permission for the removal of one oak tree.


Section 2. That the applicant is required to install (2) 24-inch box trees for this tree to be removed.
