

RESOLUTION No. 96-127

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO AN EXISTING CONTRACT
WITH MSE ENVIRONMENTAL, INC. FOR COORDINATION OF A
HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENT**

WHEREAS, as part of the City's adopted Source Reduction and Recycling Element (SRRE) and Household Hazardous Waste Element (HHWE) the City must hold household hazardous waste collection events; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously approved an agreement with MSE Environmental, Inc. upon the adoption of Resolution No. 95-177; and

WHEREAS, the City is now ready to hold another household hazardous waste collection event on October 26, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the existing agreement with MSE Environmental must be amended to reflect the October 26, 1996, household hazardous waste collection event date and the cost associated with this event.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The existing agreement between MSE Environmental, Inc. and the City of El Paso de Robles, dated February 28, 1996, (the Agreement) is hereby amended as follows:

“Contractor to provide planning, coordination, packaging and disposal services of household hazardous wastes for a Household Hazardous Waste Clean-up day in Paso Robles, California, on Saturday, October 26, 1996, from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.”

“**PAYMENT.** For furnishing services as specified in the Agreement, contractor shall provide city with detailed invoices of the wastes collected. City will make payments based upon the actual work completed by the contractor and the unit prices described in Exhibit “A”. The total amount of payment under the Agreement shall not exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).”

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve the amendment to the Agreement between MSE Environmental, Inc. and the City of El Paso de Robles, dated February 28, 1996.

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does authorize funding for the event in the amount of \$20,000.00 be taken from unallocated Solid Waste Operation funds and placed into the landfill Maintenance and Operations budget account number 610.350.5224.167.

EXHIBIT "A"

Pricing

Administrative/Mobilization:

This fixed cost includes planning, permitting, mobilization, set-up and tear down as indicated for performing the collection. All other costs are on a per drum charge as indicated in the Disposal and Recycling section of this proposal.

- Full Scale Households Hazardous Waste Event, 200 Cars \$5,200
- Public Relations Reservation System - "800" toll-free line and attendant (4 weeks), reminder postcard to participants 1,250
- Advertising - Create ads, determine costs, place ads (City to be directly invoiced by chosen publications) 350

Disposal:

These costs includes all labor, materials, transportation and disposal/recycling charges for the waste generated. We have provided these all inclusive costs based on the final destination of the waste stream: recycle, fuels blending, incineration and land disposal.
