## **RESOLUTION NO. <u>96 - 135</u>** A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO INCREASE THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES BUDGET BY **ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE DOLLARS AND EIGHTY FOUR CENTS (\$1,655,84)** FOR THE ABATEMENT OF A PUBLIC NUISANCE AT 1030 TURTLE CREEK APN 009-781-015

WHEREAS, on the June 6, 1996, the City Council of the City of Paso Robles by Resolution No. 96-94 directed the Department of Emergency Services to take all steps reasonably necessary to secure the structures and cause abatement of nuisances at the aforementioned property; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Services in compliance with the Paso Robles Municipal Code Section 9.06 has identified a qualified contractor to abate the property at 1030 Turtle Creek; and

WHEREAS, the cost of said abatement will cost One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Five Dollars and Eighty Four Cents (\$1,655.84); and

WHEREAS, these funds were not budgeted for in the 1996/97 budget, it will be necessary to appropriate the funds from unappropriated reserves, and the City place a tax lien for abatement and all related cost on the property tax rolls;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the \$1,655.84 shall be appropriated from unappropriated reserves, and all cost of abatement shall be recovered from property tax liens as provided for in Paso Robles Municipal Code, Section 9.06.160 (see attached).
