A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES GIVING PERMISSION TO REMOVE FOURTEEN OAK TREES FOR PHASE 4B CONSTRUCTION OF TENTATIVE TRACT 1632

WHEREAS, on January 3, 1989, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 89-02 which approved Tentative Tract 1632 for the construction of single family residential lots; and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 1996, the City received notification from the developer that the tentative tract map did not accurately reflect the existing field conditions; and

WHEREAS, these inaccuracies made it necessary to remove fourteen (14) oak trees in order to design and construct the project as originally approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council gives permission for the removal of fourteen oak trees as follows: (1) 3-inch, (1) 4-inch, (1) 7-inch, (1) 10-inch, (2) 12-inch, (3) 18-inch, (1) 22-inch, (3) 24-inch, and (1) 36-inch.

Section 2. That the applicant is required to install (2) 24-inch box trees for each tree to be removed.
