

RESOLUTION No. 97- 33

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE
CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD FOR
96/97 USED OIL RECYCLING BLOCK GRANT FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles has identified collection and recycling of used motor oil as a primary objective within the Household Hazardous Waste Element; and

WHEREAS, the improper disposal of waste motor oil causes damage to soils and groundwater; and

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles wishes to prevent improper disposal of waste oil by providing convenient methods of collection and recycling to all Paso Robles residents; and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act that provides funds to cities and counties for establishing and maintaining local used oil collection programs that encourage recycling or appropriate disposal of used oil; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the state, setting up necessary procedures governing application by cities and counties under the program; and


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles authorizes the submittal of annual applications to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for Used Oil Recycling Block Grant funds.

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does authorize the Public Works Director to execute in the name of the City of Paso Robles all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments thereto for the purposes of securing annual grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application.
