## **RESOLUTION No. 97-46**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES REQUESTING THAT FUNDS BE RE-PROGRAMMED FOR PHASE II CONSTRUCTION OF THE TRANSPORTATION CENTER

WHEREAS, the Notice Inviting Bids were made available on January 29, 1997; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 1997 six bids were received ranging from a low of \$917,900 to a high of \$1,034,000; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a funding shortfall of approximately \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the City met with San Luis Obispo Council of Governments staff and determined that there are several options to fund the shortfall.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does request San Luis Obispo Council of Governments to approve the following request to re-program funds to supplement the budget for Phase II construction of the Transportation Center, in the following preferential order:

- a) re-program \$110,000 currently slated towards the Theater/Vine Street bikeway project.
- b) re-program unused funds that may become available through SLOCOG.
- c) advance \$80,000 from urban SHA funds.
- d) as a last course of action, re-allocate a portion of funds from the Creston Road Sidewalk project.
