## RESOLUTION No. 97- 63

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES AUTHORIZING NIGHTTIME CLOSURE OF ALLEY

WHEREAS, there is a dead end alley south of 6th Street and east of the Post Office; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the property immediately adjacent to the alley, Dr. Jack Sloan has requested permission to close the alley during nighttime hours for security purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may permit restriction of access to alleys under Municipal Code Section 11.02; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Department does not anticipate any problems with the nighttime closure of the alley.

## THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does permit the nighttime restriction of vehicles and pedestrians in the alley located south of 6th street and east of the Post Office by allowing security gates to be installed and maintained by Dr. Sloan with appropriate notification and signage. The location of the alley and the placement of the security gates are shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 2. The type and method of installation of the security gates must be approved by the City prior to their installation. The costs of the security gates, installation and maintenance thereof shall be borne in full by Dr. Jack Sloan.
- Section 3. Dr. Jack Sloan has agreed that the security gates shall only be locked between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., and at all other times shall be unlocked and open to permit unrestricted vehicular and pedestrian access to the alley. Dr. Jack Sloan shall be responsible for both locking and unlocking the security gates at all times designated herein.
- Section 4. Dr. Jack Sloan shall cooperate with the City to insure that the City shall, at any time or it deems necessary, be able to open such security gates to gain access to the alley, in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

Section 5. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby find that this action is necessary to protect the public safety and welfare.
