A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY AS SURPLUS

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the Director of Administrative Services is authorized to undertake any and all actions to transfer title to the successful bidder/purchaser.

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
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Exhibit A
