A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
TO CONSIDER A REQUEST FROM A SUB-COMMITTEE OF THE PASO ROBLES MAIN STREET  
ASSOCIATION TO RESTORE THE CITY PARK FOUNTAIN FOR USE DURING SPECIAL  
EVENTS IN THE CITY PARK.

WHEREAS, the recirculating City Park fountain was constructed in the early 1990's as a part of an extensive City Park upgrade, and;

WHEREAS, use of the fountain was discontinued in the late 1990s but was reactivated in 2001 at the request of the Paso Robles Main Street Association, and;

WHEREAS, use of the City Park fountain was again discontinued approximately 3 years ago to encourage water conservation and as a cost-cutting measure, and;

WHEREAS, the Uptown/Town Centre Specific Plan calls for removing the raised planter and fountain areas, replacing them with a Grand Plaza, and;

WHEREAS, the fountain area, wrought iron fence and adjacent planter area are in need of restoration, and;

WHEREAS, a sub-committee of the Paso Robles Main St. Association is collecting funds to restore the fountain area of City Park, and;

WHEREAS, the committee has offered to pay all expenses associated with the repair of the fountain and adjacent area and will provide volunteers for clean-up, painting and planting in the surrounding area, and;

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee voted 3-1 at its April 10, 2012 meeting in favor of the restoration project so long as none of the costs to repair and run the fountain are passed along to the City,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, that a sub-committee of the Paso Robles Main St. Association be authorized to further explore the cost of repairing the City Park fountain, recommend a schedule of fountain operation, and research the possibility of using Tourism Committee funds to defray the cost of operation. Council will also consider funding intermittent use of the fountain when recovery priorities are reviewed with the June 2012 Financial Forecast update.


