A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF ONE OAK TREE IN THE CHAROLAIS ROAD CORRIDOR
TRAIL PROJECT (CITY INITIATED)

WHEREAS, the City Public Works Department is requesting the removal of one 28-inch multi-trunk oak tree (*Quercus Agrifolia*) in relation to the construction of the Charolais Road Multi-use Trail; and

WHEREAS, the Arborist has indicated that as a result of the tree being a multi-trunk, and the tree being damaged over the years by erosion from the area drainage, that the tree is in poor condition and should be removed; and

WHEREAS, Rick Engineering has indicated that the area of the tree needs significant grading to provide for the area drainage and to prevent future erosion, and the tree will be impacted by the grading; and

WHEREAS, the Director could not make the determination that the tree is “clearly dead or diseased beyond correction,” and therefore, Section 10.01.050.C of the Oak Tree Ordinance would consider the tree “healthy” and require that the City Council make the determination of whether the tree should be removed or not, after consideration of the factors listed in Section 10.01.050.D; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby:

1. Authorize the removal of one (1) 28-inch multi-trunk Coast Live Oak as a result of the tree being in poor condition;
2. Require the planting of five (5) 1.5-inch diameter Coast Live Oak replacement trees; to be planted with the Charolais Road Corridor Trail Project.


