

RESOLUTION NO. 12-082

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROVING THE SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR THE
PASO ROBLES UPTOWN FAMILY PARK

WHEREAS, following an application process that began in February 2010, and the award of a Proposition 84 Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant in the amount of \$2,575,000 in November 2010, on May 17, 2011, City Council authorized contracts with (1) the State of California accepting the grant of \$2,575,000; and (2) the San Luis Obispo County Office of Education, for a 30-year Ground Lease Agreement for the construction and operation of the Uptown Family Park on the First Five property at 641 36th Street; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2011, City Council authorized staff to commence negotiations with Verde Design to provide design services for the Uptown Family Park; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2012, City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Verde Design, Inc. in the amount of \$221,838.50; and

WHEREAS, Verde Design has creatively incorporated all park elements mandated by the Proposition 84 Grant, designing a low-maintenance yet innovative park environment which provides an attractive City gateway, educational components to complement the adjacent First 5 Early Childhood Education Center and intergenerational amenities to attract park-goers of all ages; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will cover all Uptown Family Park design and construction costs.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby approve the schematic design for the Paso Robles Uptown Family Park.

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
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
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
