

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-110**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
AMENDING A CONTRACT WITH BLACK & VEATCH TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING  
SERVICES DURING BIDDING, CONSTRUCTION, AND STARTUP  
OF THE CITY'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE**

WHEREAS, in 2008, after an exhaustive selection process, the City awarded a contract to the engineering firm Black & Veatch to plan and prepare a preliminary design for the upgrade of the City's wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) at 3200 Sulphur Springs Road.

WHEREAS, in 2010, the City amended the contract with Black & Veatch to prepare construction-ready plans and specifications for the WWTP upgrade.

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications are now complete. The environmental review process is complete and all major environmental permits have been issued. Funding is secure and the City has applied for a low interest construction loan. In June 2012, the City hired the Covello Group for construction management services. The project will be ready to advertise for construction bids in October 2012.

WHEREAS, Black & Veatch demonstrated good performance, time management, and cost control during the planning and design phases of the WWTP upgrade.

WHEREAS, bidding, construction, and startup of the WWTP upgrade will require Black & Veatch's engineering services.

WHEREAS, the City requested Black & Veatch prepare a comprehensive scope of work for engineering services during bidding, construction, and startup of the WWTP upgrade. The work will require approximately 10,800 man-hours throughout the 27 month project duration and is estimated to cost \$1,756,700.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council does hereby amend a contract to Black & Veatch for engineering services during bidding, construction, and startup of the Paso Robles Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade in an amount not to exceed \$1,756,700, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract amendment.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:
