

RESOLUTION NO. 12-129

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
APPROPRIATING 2012 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS AND RE-
PROGRAMMED 2010 CDBG FUNDS

WHEREAS, at its meeting of March 8, 2012, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles (City) adopted Resolution 12-059 determining that the following activities were to be funded with the City's 2012 allotment of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and program income (which collectively were estimated to be \$167,775) and with \$25,352 in re-programmed 2010 funds from the Riverside Avenue Sidewalks Project:

 - a. \$89,609 for the Sidewalks in Turtle Creek Park is appropriated to Account No. 227-910-5452-386;
 - b. \$20,000 for Handicapped Ramps is appropriated to Account No. 227-910-5452-381;
 - c. A total of \$25,166 is appropriated to Account No. 227-710-5235-211 for the following activities:


