

RESOLUTION NO. 12-139

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR RESTORATION PLANTINGS
FOR THE SOUTH RIVER ROAD BIKE/PEDESTRIAN PATH PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City received a grant to construct a bike/pedestrian path along South River Road between Navajo Avenue and the 13th Street Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the approved environmental documents for the project require the City to submit a Habitat Mitigation and Monitoring Plan (HMMP) to the California Department of Fish and Game; and

WHEREAS, the HMMP requires provision of a restoration and revegetation plan to address the project's impact on the riparian habitat; and

WHEREAS, the restoration and revegetation plan will employ various propagation techniques using regionally appropriate plant material to restore disturbed soil and enhance areas adjacent to the proposed path; and

WHEREAS, the HMMP will be accomplished in four major phases: Phase 1, collect native seeds (Fall/Winter 2012); Phase 2, propagation of plant materials off site (May - September 2013); Phase 3, plant installation (October - December 2013, after first rains); Phase 4, maintenance and monitoring to ensure plant establishment (for 3 years); and

WHEREAS, bid documents were prepared and advertised and at the bid opening on July 19, 2012, three bids were received ranging from \$126,821.80 to \$155,966.30; and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the low bid submitted by Spiess Construction (SCCI) and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded by a Transit Enhancement Act (TEA) Grant in the amount of \$1,155,000 secured through the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby award the contract for restoration plantings for the South River Road bike/pedestrian path project to Spiess Construction (SCCI) in the amount of \$126,821.80, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract.
