

RESOLUTION NO. 12-191

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO PROVIDE LABOR COMPLIANCE MONITORING SERVICES
FOR PASO ROBLES UPTOWN FAMILY PARK

WHEREAS, the City was awarded and accepted a Proposition 84 Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant in the amount of \$2,575,000.00; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2011, City Council authorized a contact with the San Luis Obispo County Office of Education for a 30-year Ground Lease Agreement for the construction and operation of the Uptown Family Park on the First Five property at 641 36th Street; and

WHEREAS, all Grantees must provide a certified and approved Labor Compliance Program prior to requesting reimbursement of any on-site construction costs performed by a contractor; and

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2012, the City issued an Invitation to Submit Proposals to provide labor compliance monitoring services for the Paso Robles Uptown Family Park; and

WHEREAS, seven firms submitted proposals; and

WHEREAS, based on proposal review, reflected scope of work, demonstrated experience and an interview, staff recommends that LCP, Inc. be retained to provide the City with labor compliance monitoring services; and

WHEREAS, Grant funds will cover all Uptown Family Park labor compliance program costs, with fees as follows: contracted fee - \$11,000.00, contingency - \$1,100.00, for a total of \$12,100.00.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby approve a program budget of \$12,100.00, wholly funded by a Proposition 84 Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant.

SECTION 2. The City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with LCP, Inc. in the amount of \$11,000.00.
