

RESOLUTION NO. 13-121

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO PROVIDE CONCEPT PLANNING SERVICES FOR
PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles holds title to a parcel of land that was once the wastewater treatment plant for a State of California juvenile detention facility; and

WHEREAS, transfer of the property to the City was predicated on it being used for the purpose of developing an Emergency Services training facility; and

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2013, the City issued an Invitation to Submit Statements of Qualifications and Proposals to provide concept planning services for a new public safety training center; and

WHEREAS, seven firms submitted proposals; and

WHEREAS, based on proposal review, reflected scope of work, demonstrated experience and interviews, staff recommends that HMC Architects be retained to provide the City with concept planning services; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Impact Fees fund will cover concept planning costs as follows: design fee - \$102,500, contingency - \$10,250, for a total of \$112,750.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby approve a concept planning budget of \$112,750, funds being appropriated from the Fire Impact Fees fund balance to Budget No. 212-910-5452-671.

SECTION 2. The City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with HMC Architects in the amount of \$102,500.
