

RESOLUTION NO. 13-155

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AUTHORIZING A NEW CITY FLAG

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2013, City Council considered a proposal for a new City flag design; and

WHEREAS, citing concerns that the proposed design did not adequately identify the City, Council voted to reject the proposed design; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the October 15 decision, five City flag designs were distributed to the members of the community-wide 125th Anniversary Committee for their consideration and vote; and

WHEREAS, one of the five designs emerged as the clear favorite, receiving 20 out of 26 votes; and

WHEREAS, those voting represented a variety of community organizations and businesses, including the Historical Society, Pioneer Day Committee, Pioneer Museum, Paso Robles Main Street Association, Paso Robles Chamber of Commerce, Paso Robles Joint Union School District, Friends of the Paso Robles Library, Hispanic Business Association, Paso Robles Library Foundation, Senior Citizen Advisory Committee, Kennedy Club Fitness and *Paso Robles Press*; and

WHEREAS, these members of the City's 125th Anniversary Committee have consistently supported the idea of presenting the community with a new City flag on the occasion of our quasiquicentennial in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the stock of eleven current City flags will be distributed among local history groups for their archives, included in a City time capsule during anniversary festivities, and offered as silent auction items at the anniversary kick-off gala on December 31, 2013 – funds to benefit the 125th committee and, ultimately, local history groups;

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, to authorize a new City flag in crimson and white on the occasion of the City's 125th anniversary in 2014.
