A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY AS SURPLUS

WHEREAS, the City no longer has a need or use for the equipment listed on Exhibit A due to age, obsolescence and/or cost of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, it is highly desirable to sell or dispose of the surplus equipment for the highest return possible;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the City property identified in the attached Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference, is declared surplus and is to be sold by public auction, bid or sale at the least cost, donation to another public entity, or greatest benefit to the City, as determined by the Director of Administrative Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the Director of Administrative Services is authorized to undertake any and all actions to transfer title to the successful bidder/purchaser or donee.
