

RESOLUTION NO. 14-010

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF THE DRAFT 2014 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE
URBAN COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO WITH ITS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR
ALLOCATIONS OF 2014 HOME AND ESG PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2011 the City of El Paso de Robles (City) adopted Resolution 11-059 approving a renewal of the Cooperation Agreement with the County of San Luis Obispo (County) in which the City and County agreed to form an “Urban County” for purposes of allocating annual entitlements to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) grant programs administered by the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, via the Cooperation Agreement, the City agree to cooperate in the preparation of the Consolidated Plan and the annual allocation of HOME and ESG funds as set forth in the Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2013, the urban county published a “Request for Proposals” for projects to be funded under the 2014 HOME, ESG, and ADDI Programs, which provided that proposals were to be submitted by October 15, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2013 the urban county conducted a public meeting in Atascadero for residents of the City and of northern San Luis Obispo County to ascertain the housing and community development needs to be addressed in the Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2014, the urban county conducted a public meeting in Atascadero for residents of northern San Luis Obispo County, including the City of Paso Robles, to accept comments on the Draft 2014 Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Urban County expects to receive about \$650,549 in HOME funds and about \$108,615 in ESG funds; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2014, the City published a notice in the Tribune, indicating that a public hearing would be conducted on the Draft 2014 Annual Action Plan on February 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of February 4, 2014, the City Council conducted a public hearing to obtain public testimony on the proposed Draft 2014 Annual Action Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, to recommend that the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Luis Obispo adopt the 2014 Annual Action Plan, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Community Development Department, to include the activities listed below to be funded with the 2014 HOME and ESG funds.
