

RESOLUTION NO. 14-013

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
TO ACCEPT A PROPOSAL TO INSTALL STUDENT-CREATED TILE ART ON THE  
SOUTH SIDE OF THE CITY HALL/LIBRARY BUILDING IN HONOR OF THE  
125<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES

WHEREAS, in March of 2005, the City Council established a “Visual Art in Public Places Program” to stimulate investment in public art displays; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee (PRAC) is identified in the “Visual Art in Public Places Program” as the Council advisory committee relative to the selection of public art pieces; and

WHEREAS, PRAC approved at its regular meeting of November 18, 2013 a proposal by Paso Robles High School ceramics instructor, Joshua Gwiazda, to install student-created tile art on the City Hall/Library Building in honor of the City’s 125th anniversary; and

WHEREAS, the student-produced design was selected via a competitive process at Paso Robles High School; and

WHEREAS, the cost of materials is estimated not to exceed \$700, to be funded by the Paso Robles 125th Anniversary Committee; and

WHEREAS, installation is to be provided by City Public Works staff.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, to approve the installation of a ceramic tile art piece designed and created by Paso Robles High School students in honor of the City’s 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary.


