

RESOLUTION NO. 14-018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
ALLOWING THE LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND TRANSITIONS PASO  
ROBLES FOOD GROUP TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT SO LONG AS THESE  
ENTITIES SHALL MAINTAIN AND OPERATE THE GARDEN AT CENTENNIAL PARK

WHEREAS, in October, 2009, City Council first entered into a one-year, renewable agreement with Transitions Paso Robles Food Group (TPRFG) enabling the group to design, build, administer and maintain a community demonstration garden at Centennial Park; and

WHEREAS, the garden successfully demonstrates how water-intensive turf can be transformed into water-wise food production. TPRFG strives to model best gardening practices such as planting for our local climate, self-sufficiency, and sustainability.

WHEREAS, the majority of the food produced is donated to the Food Bank Coalition of San Luis Obispo County (Food Bank); and

WHEREAS, the Letter of Agreement has been renewed annually over the past 4 years, in which time TPRFG has demonstrated its sustainability in maintaining the project.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of El Paso de Robles to adopt Resolution 14-018 allowing the Letter of Agreement between the City and Transitions Paso Robles Food Group to remain in full force and effect so long as these entities shall maintain and operate the garden at Centennial Park.


