

RESOLUTION NO. 14-093

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO REFRESH STRIPING AND MARKINGS ON CITY STREETS,  
AND ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT

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WHEREAS, \$119,000 in Urban State Highway Act (USHA) grant funds, administered by the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG), are available to the City for the purpose of refreshing pavement striping and markings; and

WHEREAS, City Council directed staff on November 5, 2013, to prepare bid documents to refresh pavement striping and markings on the following streets: Theatre Drive – in front of Chili's to south City limits; Dallons Drive – Buena Vista to Jena Court; Airport Road – Meadowlark to Pioneer Trail; Paso Robles Street – US Hwy 101 to 12th Street; River Oaks Drive – South River to Buena Vista; Melody Drive – Niblick to Creston; and

WHEREAS, at the bid opening on June 5, 2014, five bids were received ranging from \$100,098.00 to \$168,105.50; and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the low bid submitted by Toste Construction, and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby allocate \$119,000 in USHA grant funds to Budget No. 1013102-52240-P0008.

SECTION 2. The City Council does hereby award a construction contract to Toste Construction, in the amount of \$100,098.00, for the purpose of refreshing pavement striping and markings, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract.
