2014 SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY INTEGRATED REGIONAL  
WATER MANAGEMENT (IWRM) PLAN

WHEREAS, the state of California's Proposition 84 Integrated Regional Water Management Program promotes integrated regional water management plans and projects to ensure reliable and sustainable water supplies, improved water quality, environmental stewardship, and strong local economies.

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles is a signatory to the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Regional Water Management Plan Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and as such has participated in development of the 2014 San Luis Obispo County Integrated Regional Water Management Plan update.

WHEREAS, the IRWM plan provides a united framework among San Luis Obispo County Region stakeholders for implementing sustainable water management projects.


WHEREAS, a state requirement of obtaining California Proposition 84 grant funding for water resources projects is that participating cities and agencies adopt the region's IRWM plan.
