Needs: For the Planning Commission to consider new street names for Tract

2772.

Facts: 1. Section 22.20.080 Street Names, of the Municipal Code, explains that the Planning Commission shall approve new street

names. (A public hearing is not needed, unless it is a street

name change.)

2. Tract 2772 is located in the Airport Sub-Area in the southwest

corner of Airport Road and Dry Creek Road.

3. The applicant has submitted the following names for the three

streets within Tract 2772:

• Boeing Street

• Hughes Parkway

• Grumman Avenue

4. The proposed names were reviewed and approved by the

Emergency Services Department as well as the Airport

Manager.

5. The County Planning Department has reviewed the proposal for

duplication of street names within the county and found no

conflicts.

Analysis and

Conclusion: Staff did not identify any concern with the proposed names. All names

represent well-known aviation companies and fit with the theme of the

airport location.
