Needs: For the Planning Commission to consider the applicant's request for a one-year

Time Extension of Tentative Parcel Map PR 05-0240.

1. The project is located at the corner 19th Street and Pine Street (see attached Vicinity Map).

2. Tentative Parcel Map is a subdivision of one parcel into three residential parcels.

- 3. The tentative map for Tentative Parcel Map PR 05-0240 was originally approved by the Planning Commission on January 10, 2006. The map approval is set to expire on January 10, 2008. However, a request for a Time Extension was filed before the January 10, 2008 deadline, automatically extending the entitlement for the project for 60 days.
- 4. Per §66452.6(e) of the Subdivision Map Act, the map may be extended by a period or periods not exceeding a total of five years.
- 5. At this time, the applicant is in the process of working through financial details for the project.

Analysis and

Facts:

Conclusion: Staff has reviewed the Time Extension request and has not identified any

significant issues. There have been no changes in the General Plan or Zoning Regulations since the original approval in 2006 that would impact the prior

approvals of this project or the conditions that were imposed with it.

Fiscal

Impact: There are no specific fiscal impacts associated with approval of this Time

Extension.


Options:

After consideration of public testimony, the Planning Commission should consider one of the following options:


- a. Adopt a resolution granting a one-year Time Extension for Tentative Parcel Map PR 05-0240 extending the expiration date to January 10, 2009.
