Facts: 1. The project is located at 834 & 844 20th Street (see attached location

2. TPM PR 04-0496 is a proposal to subdivide a 7,000 square foot parcel with an existing duplex into two single family residential parcels. The two units will be on separate lots, but will still share a common wall.

- 3. Tentative Parcel Map PR 04-0496 was originally approved by the Planning Commission on November 23, 2004 and extended an additional year on January 9, 2007. A request for the time extension was made before the deadline.
- 4. Per §66452.6(e) the map may be extended by the legislative body for a period or periods not exceeding a total of five years.
- 5. At this time, the applicant is in the process of starting the improvements to the existing duplex.

Analysis and

Conclusion:

Staff has reviewed the Time Extension request and has identified no significant issues. There have been no changes in the General Plan or Zoning Regulations since the original approval in 2004 that would impact the prior approvals for this project. The conditions that were approved with this project will remain in effect should the Commission approve this Time Extension.

Extension.




After consideration of public testimony, the Planning Commission should consider one of the following options:
