Discussion: Staff presented the plan that would replace an existing sports lighting pole

with a new cellular mono pole with incorporated sports lighting. The diameter

of the pole would be larger than the sports lighting pole in order to accommodate the cables within the pole. The proposed pole would be consistent with two other mono poles approved by the Commission for the

high school sports fields.
