Discussion: Staff presented the project including the proposed tentative tract map. There

was discussion that lots 4 and 5 would incorporate the hillside and would be responsible for maintaining it. There was also discussion on why there are no windows on the side elevations of the second floor of the two model plans? The DRC indicated that it would be nice to have windows on the floors to improve the buildings architecturally, and also allow for additional interior

light.

Staff pointed out that this project is going forward to the Commission prior to the adoption of the Town Center Specific Plan. The current zoning code will require PD modification to allow 5-foot side yard setbacks for the second floors, also the Planning Commission will have to review and approve the

proposed tandem parking for three out of the five homes.

Action: No action was taken, the DRC recommended that the Planning Commission

approve the project with the request for 5-foot second story setbacks and the use of tandem parking. The DRC did request that the applicants be able to discuss the possibility of adding windows to the second floor side elevations.
