SUBJECT: STREET ABANDONMENT 12-002 (CITY)

DATE: JUNE 26, 2012

Needs:

For the Planning Commission to make the following recommendations to the City Council regarding abandonment (vacation) of fragments of rights-of-way for Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way at Paso Robles Airport:

- a. Find that the abandonment of fragments of rights-of-way for both Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way is consistent with the General Plan;
- b. Consider approval of the proposed abandonment.

Facts:

- 1. Wing Way was constructed along with the terminal facility in 2001 in its alignment today.
- 2. Abandonment of un-used right-of-way fragments will allow for recordation of a parcel map that will adjust lease site Parcels 11, 13, 21 and 24 and will provide the right-of-way for the current entrance road to the Airport terminal (See Exhibit A).
- 3. The fragments of right-of-ways proposed for abandonment are indicated on the aerial photo (See Exhibit B).
- 4. Section 65402(a) of the Government Code provides that "...no street shall be vacated or abandoned, ... if the adopted general plan or part thereof applies thereto, until the location, purpose and extent of such... street vacation or abandonment... have been submitted to and reported upon by the planning agency as to conformity with said adopted general plan or part thereof."

# Analysis and

Conclusion:

### General Plan Consistency

The fragments of right-of-way proposed for abandonment serve no purpose for public streets.

#### <u>Abandonment</u>

Sections 8330, 8331, and 8333 of the State Streets and Highways Code provide that the City Council may "summarily" vacate a street that has been superseded by relocation provided that the vacation:

 Does not cut off all access to a person's property which, prior to relocation, adjoined the street or highway.

- For a period of five consecutive years, the street has been impassable for vehicular travel and no public money was expended for maintenance on the street during such period.
- Does not terminate a public service easement, provided that the easement:
  - ➤ Has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated or acquired for five consecutive years immediately preceding the proposed vacation; and
  - ➤ Has been superseded by relocation, or determined to be excess by the easement holder, and there are no other public facilities located within the easement.

The proposed abandonments comply with all of the above items.

Options: That the Planning Commission make the following recommendations to the City

Council regarding the proposed abandonment:

a. That the City Council adopt the attached resolution conditionally approving the abandonment of fragments of rights-of-way for Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way;

b. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES VACATING A PORTION OF UNUSED RIGHT-OF-WAYS OF TAXI-WAY "D" AND WING WAY

WHEREAS, in 2001, Wing Way was constructed between Airport Road and the new terminal building at the Paso Robles Airport; and

WHEREAS, abandonment of right-of-way fragments of Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way will allow for recordation of a parcel map that will adjust the boundaries of lease site parcels 11, 13, 21 and 24 to be more reasonably aligned with existing improvements; and

WHEREAS, the unused portions of right-of-way for Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way are not specifically shown in the Circulation Element of the General Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 65402(a) of the Government Code provides that "...no street shall be vacated or abandoned, ... if the adopted general plan or part thereof applies thereto, until the location, purpose and extent of such... street vacation or abandonment... has been submitted to and reported upon by the planning agency as to conformity with said adopted general plan or part thereof"; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of June 26, 2012, the Planning Commission recommended that the City Council find that the proposed vacation of portions of Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way as described in Exhibits "A-1"; "B-1" and "A-2"; "B-2" to be consistent with the General Plan and approve said vacation; and

WHEREAS, the unused portions of right-of-way for Wing Way and Taxi-Way "D" have not been shown as necessary for access to any other private properties; and

WHEREAS, the portions of Wing Way and Taxi-Way "D" considered for abandonment have been impassable for vehicle travel for more than five years; and

WHEREAS, no public money has been expended for maintenance of the portions of Wing Way and Taxi-Way "D" considered for abandonment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Streets and Highways Code 8331, these portions of Wing Way and Taxi-Way "D" may be considered for summary vacation; and

WHEREAS, based on the staff report, staff presentation and having heard all evidence offered by any person interested in the proposed vacation, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the

portions of Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way described in Exhibits "A-1"; "B-1" and "A-2"; "B-2" attached to this Resolution, are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EL PASO de ROBLES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The proposed vacation of portions of Taxi-Way "D" and Wing Way shown on Exhibits "A-1"; "B-1" and "A-2"; "B-2", is consistent with the General Plan for the City of El Paso de Robles.






Exhibit "B-1"

The abandonment of that portion of Taxiway "D" that lies between Wing Way and Airport Road located at the Paso Robles Municipal Airport and as shown on Parcel Map PRAL88-207 and recorded in Book 48 of Parcel Maps at Page 23, said abandonment being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the North right-of-way line of Taxiway "D" and the East right-of-way line of Airport Road, said point of intersection being the southwest corner of Parcel 13 of said Parcel Map PRAL88-207 and also being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of this description; thence along the north right-of-way line of Taxiway "D," South 88°23'01" East, 93.18 feet to the southeast corner of said Parcel 13, said corner being a point on the curve of the westerly right-of-way line of Wing Way; thence along said curve to the left, having a radius of 334.00 feet, through a central angle of 4°49'17" and a length of 28.11 feet; thence South 01°53'26" West, 31.93 feet to the northeast corner of that parcel designated as "Landscape, Drainage and P.U.E." on said Parcel Map PR88-207, said corner also being the point of intersection of the south right-of-way line of Taxiway "D" and the west right-of-way line of Wing Way; thence along the south right-of-way line of Taxiway "D," North 88°23'10" West, 92.00 feet to the point of intersection with the east right-of-way line of Airport Road; thence along the east right-of-way line of Airport Road, North 01°53'26" East, 60.01 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Beginning at the most southerly corner of Parcel 11 of said Parcel Map, said southerly corner also being a common corner between Parcels 11 and 13 and being a point on the northwesterly right-of-way line of Wing Way; thence along said northwesterly right-of-way line North 63°19' 02" East, 88.10 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of this description, the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING also being the beginning of a curve to the left; thence along said curve having a radius of 266.00 feet, a length of 252.94 feet and a central angle of 54° 28' 58"; thence South 01° 41' 10" West, 123.14 feet; thence South 63°19' 02" West, 155.76 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
