Discussion: Dave Mahn presented the plans for the two signs proposed on the building. He indicated that the signs were halo lit, as well as internally illuminated, with the orange background not being lit (opaque).
Action: The sign plans were approved as proposed.

Applicant: Covelop, Inc.
Discussion: Keith Hall, project Architect presented a landscape plan for parking lot associated with the tractor sales business. He indicated that there would only be a “couple” pieces of equipment displayed in the area and security fencing is not necessary. Staff indicated that the zoning code does not require fencing for an outdoor display area, and that it was not necessary for the question of whether the fence should be removed or not to back to the Commission.
Action: The DRC on a 2-1 vote (Rollins dissenting) approved the request to not install the fence around the display parking lot area.

Application: Modification to gate entry feature between the existing hotel site and the new hotel site on 12th Street, elimination of a water tank building, and a request for a determination of consistency of proposed changes with approved PD 16-006
Location: 600 12th Street
Applicant: Martin Resorts, Paso Robles Inn
Discussion: The applicant discussed their change of business plans, that the PRI will be capping the sulfur springs water well and discontinuing use of mineral water at the hotel. Therefore, the water tank building is not needed and is planned to be eliminated from the plans. Additionally, the paseo entry arch had been scaled and designed to complement the water tank building. With the removal of the tank building, the arch was modified to be at a more appropriate scale. The redesign complements the architectural features and finishes (e.g. use of brick and metal sculpture) and would be an attractive feature of the project.
Action: The DRC (on a 2-1 vote, Rollins dissenting) approved the modified arch entry at the paseo and elimination of the tank building.
