3. FILE #: **CODE AMENDMENT 07-002**

Transient Occupancy shall include identifying the time limits for transient occupants as it applies to a range of occupancies including hotels, motels, vacation rentals, timeshares, villas, casitas, cottages, and other types of lodging.

Action: A motion was made by Commissioner Flynn, seconded by Commissioner Johnson, and passed 6-0-1 (Commissioner Steinbeck absent), to recommend that the City Council approve adding definitions for Transient Occupancy as presented and approval of the environmental determination.
