

RESOLUTION NO: 99-067

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
GRANTING NEGATIVE DECLARATION STATUS
FOR PLANNED DEVELOPMENT 99014
(APPLICANT: CITY OF PASO ROBLES)

WHEREAS, the City has initiated an application for Planned Development 99014, a proposal to develop a 39,000 square foot Public Safety Center to house the main operations for both the Police Department and Emergency Services Department, including an Emergency Operations Center, on an approximate 2 acre site located on the city block bordered by 9th, 10th, Park and Pine Streets; and

WHEREAS, an Initial Study was prepared for this project (included as an attachment to this resolution) which concludes and proposes that a mitigated Negative Declaration be approved; and

WHEREAS, Public Notice of the proposed Negative Declaration was given as required by Section 21092 of the Public Resources Code; and

WHEREAS, public review of the Mitigated Negative Declaration document commenced on September 8, 1999, and public comments were solicited through a 20 day review period that concluded on September 28, 1999; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission on September 28, 1999 to consider the Initial Study prepared for this application, and to accept public testimony regarding this proposed environmental determination; and

WHEREAS, based on the information contained in the Initial Study prepared for this project and testimony received as a result of the public notice, the Planning Commission finds no substantial evidence that there would be a significant impact on the environment if the application was approved with mitigation measures as described in that initial study and contained in the resolution approving PD 99014 as site specific conditions number 4 (aesthetics), 7 (aesthetics), 9 (lighting) and 16 (oak trees).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Planning Commission of the City of El Paso de

Robles, based on its independent judgment, to approve a Negative Declaration for Planned Development 99014 in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act.
