## A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES GRANTING NEGATIVE DECLARATION STATUS FOR DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT M 01-002 STREET RESURFACING (APPLICANT: CITY OF PASO ROBLES)

WHEREAS, the City has initiated an application with the State of California for funding to accomplish a street resurfacing project for three (3) segments of public street within the City of Paso Robles, and

WHEREAS, the three street segments proposed for pavement resurfacing are: Pine Street, between the Train Station and 13<sup>th</sup> Street; Riverside Avenue, between Hwy 101 and 13<sup>th</sup> Street; and Buena Vista Road, between Hwy 46 and Experimental Station Road, and

WHEREAS, an Initial Study was prepared for this project and concluded that the preparation of a Negative Declaration was appropriate, and

WHEREAS, the City is pursuing State funding for these street resurfacing projects and has prepared a Negative Declaration in accordance with CEQA.

WHEREAS, public notice of the proposed Negative Declaration was given as required by Section 21092 of the Public Resources Code, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission on February 13, 2001 to accept public testimony and consider the Negative Declaration document for this project, and

WHEREAS, based on the information contained in the Initial Study prepared for this project and testimony and public input received as a result of the public notice, the Planning Commission finds no substantial evidence that there would be a significant impact on the environment if the application was approved with mitigation measures as described in that initial study and contained in the Mitigation Table attached as Exhibit A to this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Planning Commission of the City of El Paso de Robles, based on its independent judgment, to approve a Negative Declaration for Department of

Public Works Project M 01-002 (Street Resurfacing) in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act.
