## A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES RECOMMENDING THE CITY COUNCIL DENY STREET ABANDONMENT 04-006 SEEKING TO VACATE THAT PORTION OF 38<sup>TH</sup> STREET BOUNDED BY VINE STREET ON THE WEST AND OAK STREET ON THE EAST (VERNON)

WHEREAS, an application for a Street Abandonment 04-006 has been filed by Brad Vernon, being the adjacent property owner; and

WHEREAS, the proposal is to abandon 38<sup>th</sup> Street bounded on the west by Vine Street and on the east by Oak Street; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is requesting abandonment of this public street on the basis that it is minimally improved in this area and is not needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, 38<sup>th</sup> Street is necessary for traffic circulation in the City, and its abandonment would not be in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, these applications are categorically exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15301 of the State Guidelines to Implement the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, on January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing, considered the facts presented in the staff report for proposed Street Abandonment 04-006, and accepted public testimony on these applications; and

WHEREAS, based on the public testimony provided and the provisions of the City's Municipal Code for abandoning a public street, the Planning Commission:

Recommends to the City Council that the proposed Street Abandonment application be denied.
