WHEREAS, Tentative Tract Map 2782/Specific Plan Amendment 05-004 has been filed by Chad Wittstrom; and

WHEREAS, Tentative Tract Map 2782/Specific Plan Amendment 05-004 is an application to subdivide property into 7 parcels and to extend Experimental Station Road as a rural local street to end in a culde-sac; and

WHEREAS, the project is consistent with the General Plan land use designation RSF-1 (Residential Single-Family) and the Zoning district which is R1-B4 (Residential Single Family); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Statutes and Guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and the City's Procedures for Implementing CEQA, an Initial Study and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared and circulated for public review and comment; and

WHEREAS, no public comments or responses were received in regard to the Draft Negative Declaration and Initial Study; and

WHEREAS, Public Notice of the proposed Draft Negative Declaration was posted as required by Section 21092 of the Public Resources Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission on November 22, 2005 to consider the Initial Study, the proposed Negative Declaration prepared for the proposed project, and to accept public testimony on the applications and environmental determination; and

WHEREAS, based on the information and analysis contained in the Initial Study prepared for this project and testimony received as a result of the public notice, the Planning Commission finds that there is no substantial evidence that there would be a significant impact on the environment as a result of the development and operation of the proposed project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Planning Commission of the City of El Paso de Robles, based on its independent judgment, that it does hereby adopt a Negative Declaration for Tentative

Tract Map 2782 and Specific Plan Amendment 05-004 in accordance with the Statutes and Guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the City's Procedures for Implementing CEQA.
