## A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES ADOPTING NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR PLANNED DEVELOPMENT AMENDMENT 03-020 FOR AN OFFICE BUILDING ADDITION AND A NEW OFFICE BUILDING LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF 4<sup>TH</sup> AND SPRING STREETS (APNs: 009-261-002, -003; AND -004)

## (APPLICANT - PACIFIC MANAGEMENT & DEVELOPMENT)

WHEREAS, Planned Development Amendment 03-020 has been filed by Pacific Management & Development; and

**WHEREAS,** Planned Development 03-020 is a proposal that includes an office addition of 5,500 s.f. to previously approved building, and a new 12,000 s.f. office building; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Plan land use designation is CC (Community Commercial) and the Zoning Ordinance district is C-2 PD (General Commercial) and office uses are permitted in these districts, and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Statutes and Guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and the City's Procedures for Implementing CEQA, an Initial Study and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared and circulated for public review and comment; and

**WHEREAS**, no public comments or responses were received in regard to the Draft Negative Declaration and Initial Study; and

**WHEREAS,** Public Notice of the proposed Negative Declaration was posted as required by Section 21092 of the Public Resources Code; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission on March 28, 2006 to consider the Initial Study, the proposed Negative Declaration prepared for the proposed project, and to accept public testimony on the Planned Development Amendment and environmental determination; and

WHEREAS, based on the information and analysis contained in the Initial Study prepared for this project and testimony received as a result of the public notice, the Planning Commission finds that there is no substantial evidence that there would be a significant impact on the environment as a result of the development and operation of the proposed project. This finding is based on the Mitigation Monitoring Program included in the General Plan Environmental Impact Report.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Planning Commission of the City of El Paso de Robles, based on its independent judgment, that it does hereby adopt a Negative Declaration for Planned

Development Amendment 03-020 in accordance with the Statutes and Guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the City's Procedures for Implementing CEQA.
