WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission on May 9, 2006 to consider the Initial Study and the proposed Negative Declaration prepared for the proposed project, and to accept public testimony on the Planned Development and environmental determination; and

WHEREAS, based on the information and analysis contained in the Initial Study prepared for this project and testimony received as a result of the public notice, the Planning Commission finds that there is no

substantial evidence that there would be a significant impact on the environment as a result of the development and operation of the proposed project. This finding is based on the Mitigation Monitoring Program included in the General Plan Environmental Impact Report.
